- Increased personal visits by Admissions Counselors and department faculty

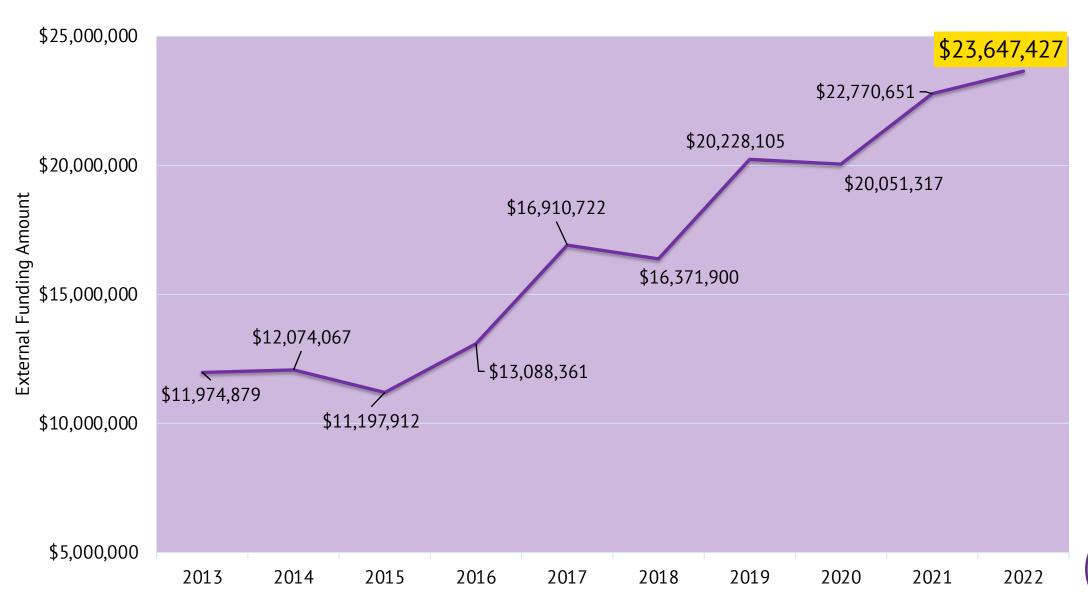


#### Remove uncertainty

- Provide good faith estimate of financial aid awarded and out-of-pocket balance by Summer Orientation



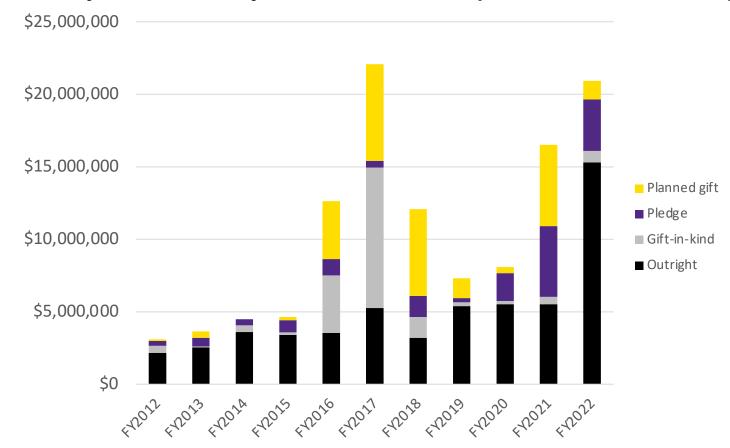

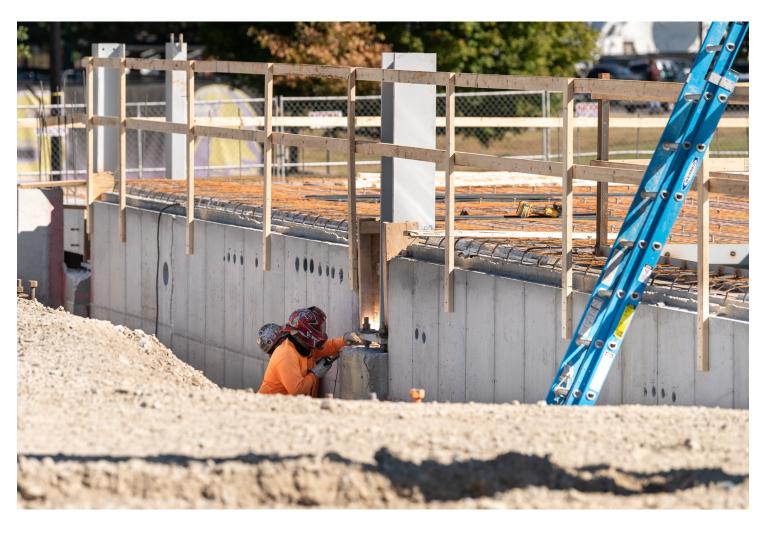
## **Fund Raising**

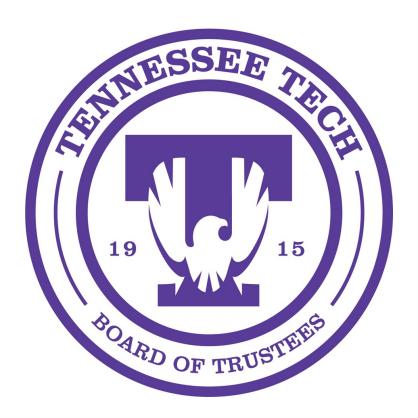

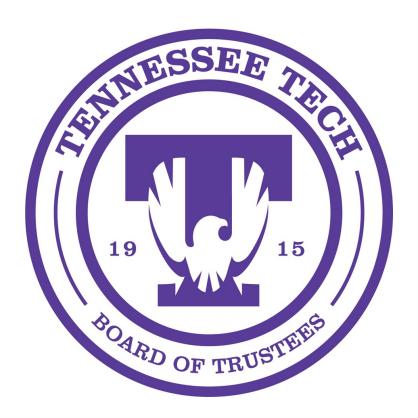

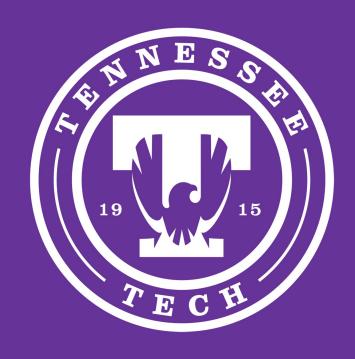
