49-8-203(a)(4)	Board granted "such other powers as are necessary" to carry out mandate similar and comparable to UT trustees.	
49-9-209(e)(1)	UT Trustees empowered to promulgate "by-laws, rules and regulations for the government of the university and the promotion of education therein as in their opinion may be expedient or necessary".
