What is the Ambassador Program?

- A selection of students with the knowledge and conduct to represent CEROC and TN Tech during outreach events
 - Will introduce/tour CEROC and CSC department to groups
 - Conduct scripted, cyber exercises for student groups (K12, community college, and university peers)
 - Assist in center-sponsored events, camps, webinars, and recruitment (for CEROC and university)
 - Provide logistical support for CEROC and campus visits/events including, but not limited to, materials prep and venue prep
 - Will be the student face of cyber at TN Tech

Roles

- Senior Ambassador \$15/hour
 - Planning/scheduling/securing supplies for events, communicating with team before and during events, setting up beforehand, and cleaning up afterwards
- Junior Ambassador \$12/hour
 - Communicate requirements with team before event, schedule team member work hours and breaks during event, setting up beforehand, cleaning up afterwards
- Ambassador \$10/hour
 - Review info needed for event, dress and act appropriately, know and follow event schedule, help with set up/clean up if needed



Expectations

- Communicate in a timely manner
- Show up on time
- Dress appropriately
- Be committed
- Professional conduct
- If accepted, you will remain active in the program until you no longer meet requirements or request to leave the program

Requirements

- 2.8 GPA or higher
- Undergrad sophomore or higher
- Full-time student in Good Standing
 - Need to be full-time both Fall and Spring semester
- Complete application process and training programs
 - Background check required
- Senior and Junior Ambassadors are required to attend a basic first-aid training session

- Networking opportunities with other cybersecurity students, faculty members, and industry workers
- Resume building experiences benefitting future career opportunities
- Become part of a national legacy of cyber excellence at TN Tech
