SMALL GROUP INSTRUCTIONAL DIAGNOSTIC

Small Group Instructional Diagnostic (SGID) is a simple and straightforward evaluation process that uses structured small group discussions among students in a class to provide confidential feedback to an instructor, generally around the midpoint of a term. This allows the instructor to make changes before the end of the semester and improve the course prior to end of course evaluations.
