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iLearn D2L Summer Updates

D2L iLearn is constantly changing to improve the user experience for instructors and students. Here are a few key changes taking place this summer.

Quizzes

Beginning in July, the Quiz tool will be updated with the following features:

- Default New Creation experience:
 - The current opt-in option will no longer be available and the new quiz creation experience will be the default view.
- Time-Bound Quiz Improvements:
 - Grace period setting will be deprecated.
 - Settings will be available to enforce a single quiz end time and to automatically submit quizzes.
 - Instructors will have the option of either showing or hiding a quiz timer during student quiz attempts.

Assignments

- Introduced in June, assignment start and end date settings can be used to specify when a student can view assignments. There are three start and end date options:
 - Visible with access restricted
 - Visible with submission restricted
 - Hidden

Also added in June, Instructors can add hotspot elements to Content images such as maps and diagrams.
Enabling students to select icon-based hotspots associated with a part of an image promotes interactive learning.
