

- **Define** acceptable and unacceptable use of AI in education, establishing transparent boundaries for students.
- Leverage edtech tools like Turnitin and Respondus to enforce academic boundaries and ensure honesty during assessments.
- Cultivate a positive classroom culture that values learning.
- Implement strategies to change the educational culture, including the use of openended questions, frequent low-stakes assessments, and reflective opportunities for student self-review.
- Thoughtfully **design** tests and questions to reduce cognitive overload and foster analytical thinking.
- Use AI tools, such as ChatGPT, to refine questions and prompts, enhancing engagement and critical thinking.
- Navigate the AI revolution in education by embracing AI assistance potential, upholding the values of integrity, fostering a culture of honesty, and nurturing an environment conducive to genuine learning.
