#### SUMMARY OF PROCEEDINGS

PROCEEDINGS <u>Approval of the Agenda</u> Dr. Miller MOVED approval of the agenda and Dr. Larimore SECONDED. Agenda APPROVED unanimously.

<u>Approval of the Minutes of the April 15, 2009 Meeting</u> Dr. Loutzenheiser MOVED approval of the minutes and Ms. Christie SECONDED. Minutes APPROVED unanimously.

#### Posting of Syllabi Proposal

Dr. Armistead stated that two committees for pandemic planning had requested that he present this to the Academic Council. The request is to have all faculty post their syllabi on the web using a course management system so that if we do have a pandemic everyone has a way of keeping in touch. The proposal is to add a statement to the current syllabus policy that the syllabus be filed in the department and posted on the class website. Dr. Larimore MOVED approval of the proposal and Dr. Bagley SECONDED. There was discussion and questions about the proposed wording, how the syllabi would be accessed online (ILearn, WebCT, Email, etc), and who would be responsible for posting. If there is a pandemic plan in each of the units/departments, why is there a need for posting of the syllabi? Dr. Larimore withdrew his motion and Dr. O'Connor MOVED that the proposal be returned to the committee(s) for further review. Dr. Roberts SECONDED and the motion was APPROVED unanimously.

# Academic Freedom Policy Revision

Dr. Armistead provided background of the Academic Freedom Policy. This item has been presented to the Faculty Senate. Prof. Smith explained AAUP's concern with the policy because it does not specify temporary faculty and feel they should have the same access and privileges as full-time faculty. The revision to the policy is to include in the last paragraph the phrase "*as well as those in non-tenurable teaching positions.*" Dr. O'Connor MOVED to revise the TTU Policy to include the phrase and to present the change to TBR for revision to their policy. Dr. Null SECONDED the motion and it was APPROVED unanimously. Dr. Armistead with pass the request on to TBR.

# Such Other Matters

- 1. A draft of the Distinguished Faculty Fellow Award was distributed to the Council for their review and will be discussed at the next meeting.
- 2. Dr. O'Connor stated that a colleague had concern about faculty with degrees from the University of Phoneix. He replied that it should be up to each search committee to review and accept transcripts.
- 3. Mr. Bedford asked about the report on the effectiveness of UNIV 1020 courses. Dr. Null stated that she would look into this and present a report at another meeting this semester.

The meeting was ADJOURNED at 4:15pm.
