What is the BRIDGES program?

The BRIDGES Early Intervention Resource Agency was established in 2016 to help support families, caregivers and children with developmental needs birth to three years old. We are under contract with the Department of Education (DOE) and Tennessee Early Intervention System (TEIS) to serve counties in the Upper Cumberland region.





What is Home-Based Developmental Therapy?

- It's team work We know that collaboration is important, so families and staff members work together.
- It's communication We encourage families to tell us what goals are most important for their child.
- It's learning Our staff will model activities to help a child grow and develop.
- It's support We are there to support the family, not just the child.
- It's flexible Our program is designed to meet families needs. Visits can be scheduled at home, child care, or any other natural setting for the child.
- It's FREE! We use toys and other safe items that you have already in your home.



How do you get Home-Based Developmental Therapy?

A referral must be made to TEIS. Anyone can make a referral, just call 1-800-852-7157



TEIS will set up an evaluation to help determine if the child is eligible.



If the child is eligible, then TEIS will assign a Service Coordinator to the family. The Service Coordinator will help the family decide on the first set of goals and set up Developmental Therapy if needed.



If the family and Service Coordinator decide Developmental Therapy is needed, the Service Coordinator will contact the appropriate program.



Once a Service Coordinator contacts us, we will assign one of our BRIDGES staff members to your family. Our Developmental Therapist will contact you and set up your first visit.
