

### **Biographical / Historical**

Ann Smartt Evins was the wife of Congressman Joe L. Evins of Tennessee. On June 7, 1935 the two were married for 47 years and had three daughters: Joanna, Jane, and Mary. Evins was born in Smartt Station, Tennessee in March of 1910 to Circuit Court Judge R.W. Smartt and Susan Annie Fancher. She graduated from Warren County Highschool adn recieved her BA from Maryville College. After graduation she taught at Smithville High School. Despite leaving the teaching profession after two years, Evins spent numerous volunteer hours tutoring students in reading. Evins was a member of many organizations and clubs including the Smithville Study Club, the Congressional Club, which organized children's activities, the Congressional Wives Prayer Group, and the Democratic Club. Evins passed away on January 3, 1983.
