



ASN-to-MSN Bridge Online Degree Program

Do you have a previous Associates Degree in Nursing and a Bachelor’s degree? Our RN-to-MSN bridge program is a fully online, 50 credit hour degree that includes all coursework required to seek Advanced Practice licensure as an FNP. Course loads are flexible and most students complete the program in 8-9 semesters/2.5-3 years of enrollment with two courses a semester. Courses are taught completely by our graduate nursing faculty and clinical hour requirements are completed with preceptors local to your area.

A dmission Requirements

- An unencumbered license to practice as a Registered Nurse in Tennessee or in the state in which your clinical assignments will be completed.
- A Bachelor’s degree and an Associates Degree in Nursing. Provisional admission for students with below a 3.0 may be considered only on a case-by-case basis.
- Completion of or planned enrollment in a statistics course.
- Please note that the FNP program admits for the Fall and Spring semesters only.

 - ◆ At least one educational reference
 - ◆ Apply for Fall admission by July 1st and for Spring admission by November 1st.
