CURRICULUM COMMITTEE MARCH MEETING UPDATES

CURRICIULUM & INSTRUCTION: Pending THEC approval, the Multidisciplinary Studies, General Concentration, B.S. is changing its name to Multidisciplinary Studies, Generalist, B.S. Upon THEC approval, four concentrations (Special Education, SE Interventionist Biology/English/History/Math) will be combined into one concentration: Special Education, Interventionist for Secondary Education Concentration, B.S.

History: In a joint effort with the Departments of Foreign Languages, Geology, Computer Science, and the Volpe Library, the Department of History launched the creation of a new minor in Digital Humanities.

Math: Upon THEC approval, the Math department has proposed the creation of four new concentrations in the Mathematics B.S. degree: Pure Mathematics, Applied Mathematics, Statistics and Data Science and Actuarial Science.

Art, Craft & Design: Pending THEC approval, SACD is changing the concentration name of General Fine Arts: Dual-Studio to General Fine Arts: Dual-Focus. The Craft Certificate is also being updated with new courses.

Music: The School of Music proposed a new concentration option in Multiple Woodwinds under the Bachelor of Music Performance Concentration.

Civil Environmental Engineering: CEE has proposed the addition of a new Construction Engineering and Management concentration.

Gen. Ed.: Deletion of MATH 1130 College Algebra from the list of approved General Education Mathematics courses.

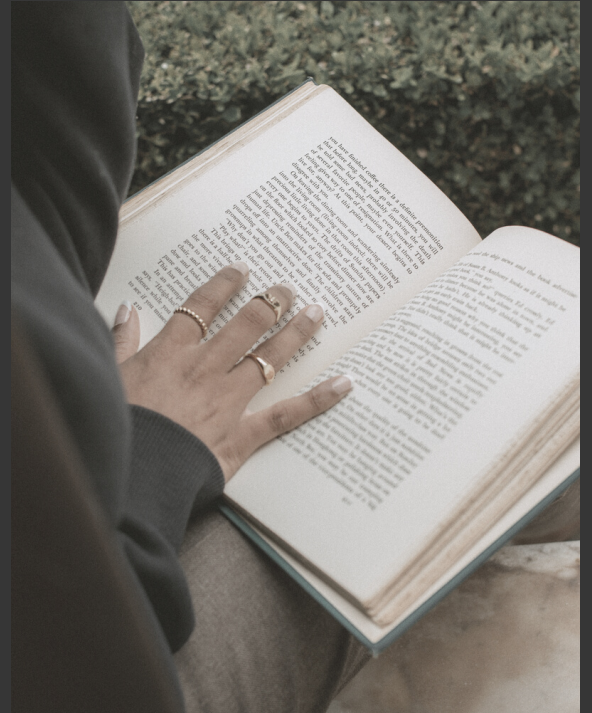
