


CURRICULUM CHANGES

Summer and Fall 2021

Twice a semester, the University Curriculum Committee meets to determine program and course changes. The Spring 2021 meeting brought the following changes:

- UNIV 1020 is being phased out.
- ART 2000/2020 was added to Gen Ed Humanities/Fine Arts.
- READ 1010/1100 (learning support) are now UNIV 1010/1100.
- Data Science concentration has a new title and is now Data Science and Artificial Intelligence.
- New Geological Engineering Concentration in Civil and Environmental Engineering.
- Basic Business is no longer a program requirement, so you will no longer see the "Basic Business" label on Business programs in the catalog.
- The Business Intelligence Analytics concentration
 has moved from the Business Management major to
 the Business and Information Technology major.
- Dual-Studio concentration name is now General Fine Arts: Dual-Studio.

required any time a student stops attending!


Substitution Workflow: The workflow now enables substitutions prior to a student being registered.
