Whereas, Russia is attacking civilian targets within Ukraine, leading to massive and

unnecessary loss of life, and,

Whereas, students who have ties to Ukraine may be in distress over the safety of their

friends and family, and,

Whereas, the SGA Senate wishes to show support to our fellow students who may be

affected by this conflict, and,

Whereas, this conflict is rapidly evolving so the Senate's actions must be swift in response,

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED, on this 28th day of February 2022 the Student Government Association hereby condemns the Russian invasion of Ukraine,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Student Government Association stands in support of Ukraine and its citizenry as they face this unprovoked war of aggression,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Student Government Association urges the administration of Tennessee Technological University to ensure that students have access to and are aware of resources available to them if they are affected by the invasion of Ukraine,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Student Government Association recommend that the University take action to show support for and solidarity with Ukraine.
